- He was until recently the Asia Editor, after previously being the launch columnist of *The Economist's Banyan* column on Asian affairs.

- He is the author of *Black Dragon River*, a journalistic travelogue which follows the Amur River and shows how this region holds a key to the complex and critical relationship between Russia and China.

- He has been the paper's Tokyo Bureau Chief (2005-9) and was China Correspondent (1994-2000) based first in Hong Kong and then Beijing.
- He returned to London as Finance and Economics Editor in 2001.
- From 1991-1994 he was Washington Correspondent, covering Bill Clinton's first years as president.
- Dominic has also edited *The Economist's* Books and Arts section, and was deputy editor of *Intelligent Life*, the group's new lifestyle magazine.
- Dominic joined *The Economist* in 1986 as a financial reporter, becoming Financial Editor in 1990.
