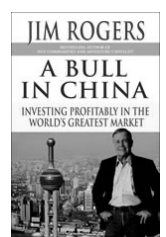
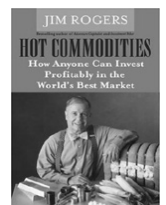
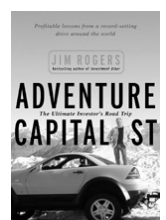
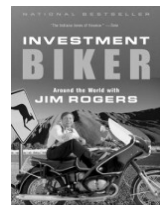


Professional Experience

- One of the world's most famously successful financial investors
- Recently moved to Singapore believing it to be 'ground-breaking time for investment in Asian markets'
- Chronicled in Jon Train's *Money Masters of our Time* and Jack Schwager's *Market Wizards* and others
- Went on a two year, 100,000 mile global motor bike tour in 1990 to discover the real world. Left again in 1999 for a three-year "Millennium Adventure" with his partner for his third Guinness World Record
- His adventures were not just travel per se but journeys to learn about the world's developing countries and investment markets first-hand; as a private investor he constantly analysed countries through which he travelled for investment ideas, striving to get to the heart of what drives successful nations and economies
