- Mark is a socio-economic strategist, writing, speaking and teaching on systems dynamics, business, government & society, economic strategy and the circular economy. He is member of the faculty at Harvard University and has advised and consulted cities, governments and UN agencies at the interface among business, technology and government.

- He is the Founder & Director of the Lab-Center for Competitiveness, a think-tank affiliated with the MOC network of Professor Michael Porter at Harvard Business School and Head of the Political Economy and Sustainable Competitiveness Initiative. He was recently appointed to be a Senior Fellow at the Global Federation of Competitiveness Councils. He researches the "Circular Economy" inside out, and his work on the topic has appeared on global publications such as the *Guardian*, World Economic Forum, *Harvard Business Review, California Management Review*, among others. He is a Research Fellow at the Institute of Competitiveness in India and a member of the Advisory Board at the Institute for Entrepreneurship and Competitiveness in Italy.
- Mark was appointed as Affiliate Faculty for the New England Complex Systems Institute. He also serves in the Board of Directors of The Academy of Business in Society (ABIS) for the 2014-17 mandate, and a member of the academic board of the think-tank, Institute for Innovation and Competitiveness (i7).
